1. SB840 (Fix to SB180) This bill would effectively fix the problems implementation of 180 has caused and is sponsored by Senator DiCeglie who also sponsored SB180. As of Friday 1/9 there was no House accompanying bill filed. A House bill could be advanced during session with a compromise to follow.
2. Property Tax Reduction. At this point 8 bills were advanced with 4 heard by various committees and 1 scheduled for continued committee hearings essentially increasing the standard non-school Homestead Exemption to \$100,000. This issue remains uncertain with no prediction offered at this time.
3. HB479 this bill prohibits local governments from creating their own rules on water quality, pollution and wetland, giving the state sole authority impacting local cities and counties efforts in environmental management.
4. SB1134 prohibits counties and cities from funding or promoting DEI making related policies void and penalizing officials found guilty of violating!
